A new community in the heart of this attractive market town

### ~ GOODEARL: WHAT IS IN THE NAME ~

At Goodearl Place, W E Black are creating a new community of family homes on a site adjacent to the mainline railway station, once occupied by furniture company - Goodearl-Risboro Ltd.

For centuries the area around Princes Risborough and High Wycombe had been synonymous with fine furniture due to the ready supply of the beech wood from the Chiltern Hills, however the craft waned in the 20th Century, but still today quality furniture maker Ercol are based in the town with a factory-outlet.

The site for Goodearl Place once housed the furniture factory for Goodearl-Risboro' Ltd, the amalgamation of two companies - Goodearl Bros. Ltd and Risboro' Furniture Ltd. The factory used the timber from the local hills as its raw material, which was sawn and kiln-dried on site. The company produced a range of kitchen and bedroom furniture in Princes Risborough, later under the name of Whiteleaf Furniture Ltd up until 2001, when the factory closed and the business relocated to nearby Thame.



The compact and attractive town centre is a designated conservation area with the Grade II Listed Market House in Market Square as its focal point. Just down the street past quaint wood-beamed buildings is the Manor House, St Mary's Church and a cottage where the aviator Amy Johnson once lived.

With through-traffic routed away via New Road, the High Street is a pleasant place with a good selection of local independent and speciality shops, complemented with an M&S Foodhall and a large Tesco supermarket. The surrounding area leaves one spoilt for choice of fine dining restaurants, wine bars and historic country pubs.

Other facilities include a lending library, a private hospital and 'Springs' swim and fitness centre. For the sporty there is a cricket club on the green, and also bowls, tennis and football clubs. Golfers can choose to play at Whiteleaf, Ellesborough or Princes Risborough Clubs.

The Chiltern Hills, being a designated area of outstanding natural beauty, is a superb place for leisure pursuits. There are numerous footpaths for all levels of walkers, including the Chiltern Way and the Ridgeway, and winding tree-lined country roads with steep hill climbs much appreciated by cyclists. Fantastic views extending far to the west, such as that from the Chalk Cross on Whiteleaf Hill.









Each year in September, the Kop Hill Climb brings motor enthusiasts to the town. Originally established in 1910, it took place annually until 1925 when, due to a fatality here, all motorsports were banned on public roads in the UK. It was revived 1999 and has been the focus of an annual revival run, as a non-competitive event raising money for charity.

Also harking back to the past is The Chinnor and Princes Risborough Steam Railway, established in 1989 with steam trains coming to the town's station once again on special days next year.
